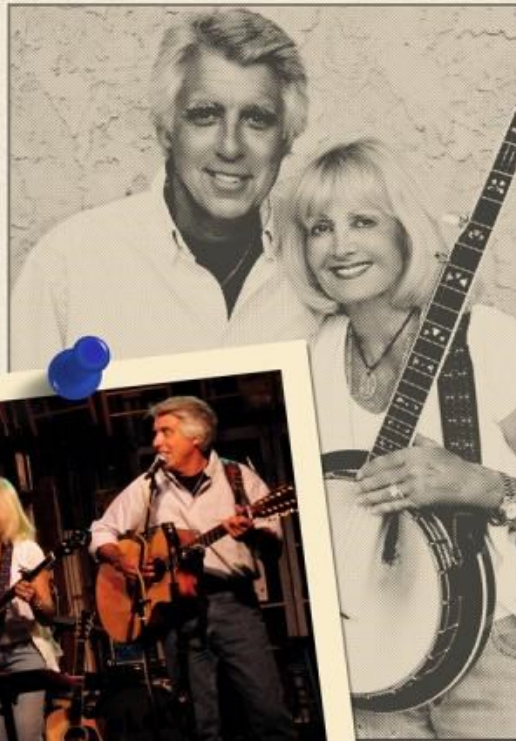

Jackie & Gary love folk music, and it shows. They have put together an evening of entertainment that, in their words, "honors the rich tradition of American folk music." And what an evening it is -- a rousing concert of memories and sing-along fun that's suited to all ages!

Folk music is in this talented duo's blood. Jackie (Miller) Davidson was one of the original New Christy Minstrels, and sang on such hits as "Green, Green," "Today" and "Saturday Night." With the group, she appeared on the Andy Williams Show and, of course, Hootenanny, and performed on many prestigious stages including Carnegie Hall and the White House. Later, she was part of the pop-folk duo "Jackie and Gayle" who were regulars on the classic Shindig show. (In fact, Jackie was the very first performer to take the stage on that show's debut telecast.)

Gary Brandt is a well seasoned singer-songwriter from Michigan, a hub of folk music activity in the Midwest. An aficionado of the works of Gordon Lightfoot, Gary is a talented balladeer who weaves rich tales of the Great Lakes and other legends in his songs.

Together, Jackie and Gary are dynamite entertainment -- and not to be missed.
